9. MEDICAL GRANTS AND MEDICAL FACILITIES AT SLAF STATIONS

An amount of Rs.1,517,000.00 for 93 members of SSWF has been paid as medical grants for the period starting from 01.06.2025 to 31.05. 2026.

OPD Medical facilities are provided to members at SLAF MI rooms. Specialist Consultation and minor Surgery and test facilities were provided at SLAF hospital Guwanpura upon request to the Director General Health Services. Due to untiring efforts and the assistance of SLAFESA, SLAF had confirmed that Association Members will be given in house medical treatment at SLAF Katunayake and Guwanpura Hospitals, and also free meals will be provided for patients warded for treatment. Eye operations were performed by the eye surgeon at Guwanpura hospital for members of AFESA.

10. SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

10.1 An amount of Rs.1,230,600.00 has been paid as Scholarship Grants for period 01.06.2025 to 31.05.2026, when compared to Rs.1,002,300.00 paid in the previous year. A total of 150 children of SLAFESA members following Engineering, IT, Medicine, Dental, Law, Business Management, Art and Commerce. A total of 150 children who were in this scheme have secured their degrees since the inception of this scheme in 2018.

15. HOLIDAY HOMES

15.1 Proposed Holiday Home at Diyathalawa

As stated at the last Annual General meeting, the construction work with the foundation laying ceremony of the proposed holiday bungalow facility will be commenced on 10th August 2026 at the site. Commander of the Air Force graciously directed Director General Construction Engineering and Commanding Officer DLA to accelerate the construction at the best site in his camp on a high ground on the way to the Fox Hill.

The drawings of Diyathalawa Holiday home were amended due to high cost of Rs.28.5 million to a revised cost of Rs.12.5 million for the single storey building with same land size and sq.ft.

15.2 Katharagama Holiday Bungalow

The Holiday Home at Katharagama was built by the Sri Lanka Air Force with the kind patronage of the Commander of the Air Force in 2017 for the welfare of our retired community with 03 air-conditioned rooms is now functional. **Booking can ONLY be done through the office of SLAFESA, SkyLink Office Complex, SLAF Guwanpura.**

15.3 Transit Rooms at SLAF Base Anuradhapura

a. The current members of Sri Lanka Air Force Ex-Servicemens' Association are eligible to reserve the retired Other Ranks Holiday Homes. A total of three (03) rooms have been allocated for retired Other Ranks and out of above, one (01) room to be exclusively reserved for retired disabled personnel.

b. If a retired disabled person has not reserved the said room, same could be allocated to a retired Other Ranks (07) seven days prior to the intended date of reservation. The Charges are as follows;

Charges	One day per One Room
Reservation Charges	Rs. 50.00
Service Charges	Rs. 450.00
Gas Charges	Rs. 150.00
Visitors Charges	Rs. 500.00

Note:

- a. Maximum number of adult occupants per room: 02 Adults.
- b. Age of over 14 years and above treat as adults.
- c. Maximum number of days of reservations: 03 days (Check in at 1100 hrs of arrival and check out at 0900 hrs on day of vacating).
- d. AFHQ approval is compulsory for those who hold foreign citizenships.

15.4 Malay Cove Tide Watch of WOS' & SNCOS' Cabanas at SLAF Base Academy, China Bay.

The newly constructed two (02) "Malay Cove Tide Watch Wos & SNCOs' Cabanas" are available for the reservations for serving and retired WOs and SNCOs. Both Cabanas are fully furnished with required amenities, kitchen utilities and all other essential provisions for occupancy. Each Cabana shall accommodate maximum of four (04) adults including the applicant (Children above 14 years shall be considered as adults). The cost will be Rs.1000/= per day per Cabana.

25. **ADDITIONAL MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR MEMBERS**

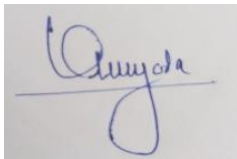
